







Stan has sent in two beautiful pictures from his nest box camera. Blue Tits laid a clutch of six eggs, and patiently sit and brood them

Cool growing Dendrobiums

Shortage of space five years ago, led to four pots of Dendrobium kingianum being put into my unheated glasshouse. The pots were plunged into a sand/perlite mixture and receive little or no water through the Winter months. The plants will have endured temperatures below freezing on many occasions but have all just flowered. This East Australian, 'frost sensitive', lithophyte may be tougher than described?
